The Whitecap Dakota First Nation is offering an apprenticeship work skills program for one full-time, term position. Take advantage of this exciting opportunity to advance your skills and enter a trade certification program!

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- Applicants must be registered band member of Whitecap Dakota First Nation
- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Candidates must meet the educational requirements for apprenticeship in Saskatchewan.
 Grade 12 or GED 12 is preferred
- To determine eligibility under the funding guidelines for the WDFN Apprenticeship program, candidates must sign a Consent Form (attached). Signing the form does not guarantee employment, however the First Nation is unable to proceed to the final screening stage until the applicants submit this form
- Candidates must commit to the indenturing, formal in-class training and employment work experience processes that are involved in Apprenticeship training and <u>have not</u> <u>previously participated in an Apprenticeship Program</u>
- The successful candidate will be subject to a Criminal Record Check as a condition of employment
