DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Journeyman Carpenter works collaboratively within the Whitecap Dakota First Nation Housing & Public Works team. The following duties **ARE NOT** intended to serve as a comprehensive list of all duties performed by all employees in this classification, only a representative summary of the primary duties and responsibilities. Incumbent(s) may not be required to perform all duties listed and may be required to perform additional, position-specific duties. In accordance with standards of the WDFN and reporting to the Director of Housing & Public Works, the Employee will be responsible for:

- ✓ Reading and interpreting architectural blueprints, diagrams, and plans
- ✓ Determining the types of material required for each project
- ✓ Take measurements and calculate the size and amount of material needed to complete tasks and builds
- ✓ Transporting the materials and equipment to each work site.
- ✓ Constructing wooden structures such as concrete forms, frameworks, scaffolding, furniture, and similar elements.
- ✓ Installing wooden structures such as frames, stairways, rafters, furniture, and partitions.
- ✓ Constructing structures such as residential homes, garages, sheds, and other similar constructs as required by the Nation
- ✓ Cutting, shaping, and smoothing lumber and other material, such as fiberglass, according to measurements and specifications
- ✓ Lay out floorings, roofing or drywalls ensuring they are leveled and compatible
- ✓ Carve and assemble furniture, cabinets, shelves, and other items and install them where designated
- ✓ Inspecting the integrity of structures upon their installation ensuring all provincial, federal, and local building codes are met
- ✓ Complying with all applicable safety regulations.
- ✓ Perform regular maintenance, completing repairs as required on residential homes and structures
- ✓ Inventory and supplies, ensuring the proper par levels are always maintained
- ✓ Training subordinates and apprentices in appropriate construction site safety standards while ensuring all job sites meet both provincial and federal safety standards
- ✓ Working with apprentices of varying levels, helping to ensure successful completion of the provincial apprenticeship program
